Wood

Fleetwood[®] products are manufactured with TFL (Thermally Fused Laminate) unless otherwise noted. HPL (High Pressure Laminate) is available upon request as a nonstandard. Contact your Learning Environment Project Coordinator for lead time and pricing.

Metal

Fleetwood[®] desks and tables are constructed using fully welded steel frames unless otherwise noted.

Hardware

European hinges, pulls and locksets are chrome for the Illusions and Designer Collections. 5-Knuckle hinges and pulls are black and locksets are chrome for the Encore Collection. 5-Knuckle hinges and pulls are black for the Harmony Collection. 5-Knuckle hinges, pulls and locksets are chrome for the Library Collection.

Care of laminate, metal, plastic finishes and chemical resistant phenolic resin work surface

Wipe product with a damp cloth to remove general soiling and water-borne stains. If needed, use a non-abrasive, all-purpose cleaner suitable for hard surfaces such as Soft Scrub®, Windex®, Glass Plus®, Formula 409®, Fantastic®, or Mr. Clean® followed by a clean water rinse and dry immediately. Abrasive or harsh chemicals may discolor or mar the finish. Do not place heat producing items directly on laminate or chemical resistant phenolic resin surfaces as it may mar the finish.

Care of maple block work surfaces

Clean tops with warm, soapy water and dry with rag or towel to remove any standing water on surface. Windex® or Formula 409® can also be used. Furniture wax can be applied periodically to bring back some of the luster which may be lost over the years.

Care of Pages™ marker boards and white marker board surfaces

Use non-toxic dry erase markers and microfiber clothes to erase. Clean the boards with soap and water only using a lint free soft cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals, especially ones that contain ammonia that will damage the finish.

Care of edge band

Use a mild liquid detergent. After cleaning, wipe the edges with a cloth dampened with warm water and dry immediately.
